## Regular Masses:

Following guidance received from the Catholic Bishops of England & Wales we regret that **all congregational worship is suspended** until further notice with effect from Friday evening 20th March.

Under the new restrictions announced on Monday 23<sup>rd</sup> March we regret that **we are no longer able to keep the church open during the day.**

## Sunday Collection and Planned Giving:

The suspension of Sunday Masses means we are losing some £1,200 per week in collection income. As you will appreciate, even though the church is closed we still have running costs and bills to pay.
