Begin with a time of silent and personal reflection, using the following prompts and allowing some time to process each stage:

- Take some moments to reflect on your life. Perhaps there are areas with which you are currently unhappy or dissatisfied, such as work, your relationships, your body, your attitude, your faith, your politics, or others.
- List those things with which you are unhappy or dissatisfied (one per slip of paper). Be as honest as you can, and do not judge whether or not your unhappiness or dissatisfaction is "good" or "bad".
- Look at your slips of paper and share their contents with God in silent prayer, listening for God's response.

- Consider releasing your unhappiness or dissatisfaction to God to tend in God's timing, love and wisdom. As you consider each item, either place that slip of paper in the small trash can or pick up a rock to represent each item and drop it into the bucket of water.
- When you are done with this reflection, spend a few moments just resting in God's presence.

## Please stay with your experience and ask yourself:

- What are some common threads to this experience?
- What are some frustrations that we might all share as the year goes on and what might we be able to do together to address them?
- How might we help others who are experiencing similar challenges?
