


Peace Keeping Force

"Orthodoxy and Heresy: Writing the History of the Church and the Papacy in the Reformation period,"

Dr. Stefan Bauer

We warmly invite you to join us in the Red Room on Friday, 20 June, at 7:30 pm for an enlightening journey through the Papacy with Dr. Stefan Bauer. In the wake of Pope Francis's passing and the election of Pope Leo XIV, this timely talk, entitled "Orthodoxy and Heresy: Writing the History of the Church and the Papacy in the Reformation period," promises to offer profound insights into the enduring battles between truth and falsehood within the Church's history.

Dr. Bauer will unravel the intricacies of orthodoxy—meaning "of the right opinion"—and how its definition has shaped religious discourse since Late Antiquity. During the Reformation period, marked by Martin Luther's transformative actions in 1517, both Catholics and Protestants wielded historical narratives as weapons to assert their legitimacy.
