Embracing a Mindful Self-Centredness

his Sunday, I invite you to reflect on a thought-provoking perspective from the Gospel of Luke, shedding light on our understanding of sin and our relationship with God. Often, our education about sin evokes imagery of an angry deity ready to punish, leaving many of us with lingering shame and fear. What if, instead, we reconsider sin as "anxious self-centredness"?

Imagine this: when we are consumed by our own anxieties and needs, we distance ourselves from God's love and the call to love others. This perspective resonates with a story I once heard from a retired minister, who introduced me to Paul Ramsey's concept of sin as anxious self-centredness. This idea invites us to see sin not as mere actions that anger God, but as a state of being where our fears of inadequacy

The powerful imagery offered by the 14thcentury monk Meister Eckhart suggests that our lives are often so filled with self that there is no room for the divine to enter. Only by emptying ourselves of the compulsive focus on 'me' can we become vessels of God's love and compassion.

What does this look like in our daily lives? It means shifting from a mindset of scarcity—of never being or having enough—to one of



abundance, recognizing the sacredness within ourselves and others. It's a transition from living anxiously for ourselves to living mindfully with a focus on a Greater Self, where God resides.


This week, may we aspire to let go of anxious self-centredness, allowing God's peace to flow into and through us, transforming us into beacons of love and hope in the world.


